There is no waiting time and account activation and Slice creation is instant.



Our Slices sizes and resource allocations are summarised on the main Slicehost site:





Sign up form

The sign up form has various sections that need to be completed.

Billing Name and email address



Once you submit the form, you will be logged into the SliceManager where you will be asked to set the SliceManager password.


Your Slice will be built straight away and you will receive an email confirming your IP address and root password. Please immediately log into the Slice and change the root password.

Email and password


To sign in with your email and password, simply enter your details in the login page.

OpenID URL
